The Orange County Tobacco Free Partnership (TFP) is a group of community leaders and energetic students working against tobacco who are concerned about the effects of tobacco use in the community. The TFP, in conjunction with the American Lung Association, is currently collaborating on policy initiatives which will result in great health benefits as well as safeguarding our youth from the tobacco industry.

Locally conducted surveillance has confirmed the need for policy change in Orange County based on its alarming results. The TFP is working towards policies that would restrict minor's access to these tobacco products through increases in compliance checks and restrictions on the sales of flavored tobacco products, along with other beneficial initiatives. In addition to pursuing policy change, the TFP is committed to providing access to cessation programs within the community through AHEC services and the Florida Quitline.
