**ORANGE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT  
AWARDED \$6.6 MILLION GRANT**

The Orange County Health Department was awarded a grant on March 19 as part of the Recovery Act Prevention and Wellness Initiative, *Communities Putting Prevention to Work*. The grant will go towards tobacco prevention and control in our community. OCHD will work with the Orange County Tobacco Free Partnership to implement policy changes and will partner with key community agencies such as the American Lung Association, Orange County Public Schools, and community based organizations like the Center for Multicultural Wellness and Prevention and county and city governments to improve the health of Central Florida residents and to help prevent deaths associated with smoking and second-hand smoke.
